Vendor's Rules

1. All vendors must obtain a vendors permit from City Hall's revenue dept. on the first floor of City Hall. Cashier's check /M.O's only written out to the City Of New Orleans in the sum of \$50
2. You will be notified by the promoter when to obtain your permit.
3. An ABC fire extinguisher, restaurant type must be in display in your booth throughout the day.
4. The fire Captain will be inspecting all cooking booths, make sure it's up to date.
5. Hand wash station must be set up on your table. A five gallon water container with a tap, and a five gallon bucket to be used as a catch basin, soap, water, paper towel.
6. All vendors are responsible for their own sterno burner, lighter, extension cords, masking tape, tables and chairs, table cloth, foil. No selling of alcohol, sodas or water are to be sold by any vendor. You may sell homemade tropical drinks.
7. No grease or oil dumping on festival grounds. Bring a container from home to store old oil from frying. Please cover the ground around your frying.
8. There will be a vendor coordinator on the grounds to help answer your questions/concerns.
9. Please keep your booth area clean. All booths size will be 10x10.
10. All vendors will be issued five vending wristband, that should be worn throughout the event. Any additional help you bring must have an admission ticket.
11. No dumping of trash on the streets
